The parent/guardian will complete the Optional Attendance form and will email the completed form to home school principal. The form may be sent as a scan, a photo or a screengrab.

- The home school principal or designate (VP, office staff etc.) will sign and email the form(s) to The Grove
- The Grove will confirm receipt of the form(s) by way of email reply to the home school.
- The home school will communicate with families that the Optional Attendance Form was signed, sent and received by The Grove school.
- The home school principal or designate will track optional attendance applications to ensure that TDSB policies are being followed.
